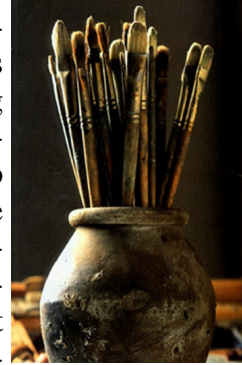
40K LEAGUE

Time to strut your generalship skills. The Warhammer 40k League kicks off at the June club meet. Over the next six months play 10 games of 40k at the club and hand in your results at the club. At the Christmas club meet, whoever is at the top of the table wins a prize, and gets immortalised on the perpetual trophy. Games must be 1500 points using all current codexes and you can't play the same opponent more than twice. A win is worth 5 points, a draw 3 points and a loss 1 point. You can sign up any time between now and the Xmas meet (but the earlier you sign up the easier it is to get your games in). Cost is free for members and \$5 for non-members (other systems will have their own leagues started in the future). Get gaming now, militiapersons.
